### What will your child be studying in English and Maths this term?



In Maths and English, we will continue to work through the new national programmes of study.

In English, our units will largely be related to our Science theme of Space; we will look at the features of biographies, discussions, narrative writing and poetry. Our class reader links with our History unit on the Victorians - Oliver Twist.



In Maths, we will be continuing our unit on fractions. Following this, we will be using multiplication and division in calculations; we will be introducing quicker, formal methods, using columns. Further to this, we will be exploring the short method for division including 'bus stop'. Later on in the term, we will move onto to covering decimals and percentages. These methods will rely on children's quick recall of timetables facts therefore any further practice or support you can give your children with their times tables at home would be appreciated.



Your child will continue to receive home learning each week. These tasks should take approximately 30 minutes each and will be given out on a Friday, to be handed in on the following Wednesday. Your child will be given spellings each week, which they will practise every day in school and they should practice these at home too. Homework club remains available every Tuesday lunchtime for those that want to attend.

In addition to this, children should still be reading regularly - please remember you can login to your 'Sora' accounts with the Library Service, where they can easily discover a wide range of books. The children also need to continue to practise their multiplication tables, 'Times Table Rockstars' is a great way to do this; your child's login details for both are on their personalised bookmark in their homework folders.

#### Other Important Information and Dates

- Since the weather can be very cold and/or wet at this time of year, children should ensure they have a suitable coat for outdoor activities. Please ensure that all items are clearly labelled.
